

HANDBIKE ITALIAN TOUR RIDE REGULATIONS

13[^] EDITION 2023

FORMULA AND ITINERARY

1.

SEO a.s.d. - hereafter CO - (cod. FCI 02K3853 - e-mail: info@girohandbike.it - website: www.girohandbike.it) indexes and organizes, with the collaboration of the Local Stage Committees and Organizers (hereinafter OL) the 13th Giro d'Italia of handbike - (hereinafter GHB).

The event focuses on several tests reserved for athletes of the categories Male (M) and Female (W) H1 - H2 - H3 - H4 - H5 - HO, according to the procedures provided for by this Regulation. As per FCI regulations, are admitted to the national competitions, as well as the category T (T1/T2/TO) Male (M) and Female (W) categories for which neither scoring nor ranking is expected. With regard to the Open HO m/f categories in distinctions 1 and 2 (recumbent/kneebike) it is specified that the same will be grouped in a unified ranking MHO and WHO with the methods of scoring shown below. The same categories will be admitted also to the International competitions.

2.

The tests forming part of the GHB, are intended to be organised and managed independently by the CO and the respective OL in accordance with Annex 1

No liability shall be attributed to the CO in case of cancellation or suspension of the tests, identified as valid to the circuit, for reasons attributed to the OL.

The CO, in order to standardize the tests, will send to the OL an "Organizational Handbook" to which they must refer in order to give uniqueness to the whole event.

3.

Participation in GHB is free and without obligation of presence at all stages. Only to compete in the final scores (Maglie Rosa e Bianca) and the respective refunds must have participated in the last test. Any absence for health reasons, can be justified by sending the relevant medical certificate, within 24 hours of the race.

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

4.

The final rankings will be made by summing the scores obtained in the individual tests.

After each test the general ranking will be established according to the order of arrival of the stage. The scores will be assigned according to the appropriate table below.

To compete in the "final ranking" must have accumulated the highest score according to this regulation.

The jerseys will be assigned for all male and female categories, excluding the tricycles W and M

REGISTRATIONS

5.

Italian athletes: through their respective clubs through the K-Sport system

Foreign Athletes: using the form published at the following address www.girohandbike.it sending it to info@girohandbike.it. Together with the registration form they must send the approval to the participation issued by the respective National Federation complete with the UCI card of their Federation.

6.

The subdivision of the categories is based on the classifications provided by the Technical Regulation of the F.C.I./U.C.I.

The score must however be awarded considering the actual category of membership.

An athlete who, during the season, changes category, for whatever reason, will have to renounce the score obtained up to that moment.

The scores are also deducted to the club in the count from the team ranking.

Each athlete is responsible for their own classification.

The official national or international classification will be considered valid for those athletes who already have it by 2022. Athletes who do not have a classification, will be enrolled in individual tests of the GHB on the basis of a self-certification, or rather the presumed classification indicated on the card, that will be considered valid until the actual official classification of the athlete himself. It will therefore be the responsibility of the athlete any loss of score due to an incorrect or incorrect self-certification.

The athlete who at the end of the GHB was still without official classification because he did not attend a useful classification session provided by the Paralympic Sector of his Federation, will be excluded from the final ranking of the Giro of its category and will not be able to compete for the assignment of the Jersey.

The exclusion of the athlete from the ranking automatically involves the cancellation of any points valid for the League Classification.

DIRECTORATE OF THE GHB

7.

The GHB CO holds the general direction of the event. It is chaired by the President of the Organization and by the members designated by the same.

In the event of any particular situation that might affect the safety conditions or distort the smooth running and consequent technical result of the race, the GHB Management, in agreement with the OL, the Race Director and the College of Commissioners, may at any time decide:

- A) To change the route of a stage;
- B) To establish a temporary neutralization of the stroke;
- C) To consider the stage as not disputed;
- D) To cancel a part of the stage as well as all the results of any intermediate rankings and decide on a new start;
- E) To keep the acquired results and to give a new departure taking into account the detachments recorded at the time of cancellation;
- F) To establish a stage arrival without having completed the entire intended route.

RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF RUNNERS

8.

All participating runners have the right, in compliance with the regulations in force, to compete in all rankings, General and special, provided by the program of the race and according to the indications given in this regulation. Therefore, they are required to conduct a responsible tender and to refrain from promoting or joining collective events that have the character of fraudulent agreements to the detriment of other competitors. They are also required to maintain a conduct aimed at avoiding insults, threats and improper behavior even during the race. Each issue will be subject to a specific complaint to the College of Race Commissioners.

Participants must also:

- A) Bring back and helmet numbers provided by the Organizer;
- B) Take care of the transponder (Chip) provided by the organizer, used for the automatic detection of the position of passages on the arrival line. (In case of non-refundable will be applied a charge of 500 euro to the athlete and/ or the Club to which it belongs that will be required during the verification of licenses of the first useful race in which the athlete and/ or the company to which it participates. Alternatively it will be deducted from any premiums due).
- C) Wear the shirt of the respective Company or World Champion and/ or National and/ Regional;
- D) The leaders of the general ranking of the various categories have the obligation to wear the Pink Jersey provided by the C.O. The owner of the jersey has the obligation to wear it from the beginning of the signature sheet operations and during any press conference;
- E) Leave space to the left of the road in case of dubbing, motorcycles and/ or cars allowed to run in the race;
- F) In case of withdrawal or not departure, immediately give notice to a Judge;
- G) As per federal regulations, it is forbidden, after passing the arrival line, to go back on the same, with the dorsal number and the transponder until the Arrival Judge gives express permission;
- H) Free immediately and in short terms, the space after the finish line to safeguard their safety and the athletes who must finish the race.

RANKINGS AND JERSEYS

9.

The rankings of runners are determined by the points classification for the stage arrivals.

9.1 General Classification - Pink Jersey

It establishes the Maglia Rosa delivered to the leaders of the general ranking.

The general ranking takes into account the order of arrival, by category, of each single stage and gives the following scores:

It will be granted 1 point also to those athletes who although starting, will not complete the race for failures and/ or falls.

In the event of a tie, the winner of the GHB will be declared the competitor who has obtained the best placement at the last test; placement given by the best race time. The athlete who leads the overall ranking of his category receives, during the Protocol Ceremony the PINK Jersey.

Tricycles M and W are excluded from this ranking.

The Maglia Rosa must be worn by the leader in order to participate in the race.

At the bottom of the Maglia Rosa there is a space (25x15 cm) for the insertion of the name of the Club of the Athlete (application by the Club itself).

The athlete who holds the Maglia Rosa who, at the start of a stage, does not wear the ranking jersey will be deducted 30 points. In case the athlete has forgotten his Official Jersey, in order to participate in the race, he must request a new one to the organizer. The value of the Jersey will be retained from the final refunds.

9.2 Ranking Best Young - Jersey White

The Maglia Bianca is created for young riders born on 1 January 1993.

The first best placed runner within the overall finish order is the stage leader and will wear the white Best Young Rider jersey according to the following scores:

At the end of the GHB, the athlete who has scored the most points will be declared the winner of the Best Young Person Ranking. In the event of a tie, the same applies to the Maglia Rosa.

The athlete leader of this ranking that is, during the stages, also the holder of the Maglia Rosa, will be recognized the points acquired from stage to stage but will be reset in the final total. You can see them recognized only if during the course of the event you lose the Maglia Rosa. The next competitor will be declared a leader, only at the moment of such concomitance.

In the event that there are no other concurrent competitors, the holder of the title and points can wear the White Jersey only during the Awards but not in the race (being the prevailing Pink Jersey).

As tricycles M and W are excluded from this ranking.

The White Jersey must be worn by the leader of the category in order to participate in the race.

It will be excluded - from this ranking (stage and final) - the leading athlete of the General classification of category (that is, wearing the Pink Jersey). He will then be considered Best Young and then winner of the White Jersey, the second best placed athlete.

At the bottom of the White Jersey has been prepared a space (25x15 cm) for the inclusion of the name of the Athlete's Society (application by the Company itself).

The athlete who owns the Maglia Bianca who, at the start of a stage, does not wear the leaderboard jersey will be reduced 10 points. In case the athlete has forgotten his Official Jersey, in order to participate in the race, he must request a new one to the organizer. The value of the Jersey will be retained from the final refunds.

9.3 League Ranking by Points - Fast Team - Red Jersey

It establishes the Red Jersey delivered, at each stage, to the Captain of the Club leader of the points ranking. In order to encourage the promotional activity of the Clubs that register Athletes and at the same time pursue the fundamental principles of GHB; As a result of the points awarded in the General Ranking of the Maglia Rosa, a ranking is established per Club based on the sum of the points won by the individual runners of the same team taking into account the provisions of the 3 paragraph of the previous article 6 (no points for category change).

The scores thus obtained will determine a stage ranking.

It is specified that even the points acquired by each athlete participating even at a single stage, will form cumulation for the ranking Society.

With equal score is worth the best placement, the team, the last test. In the event of further parity will be taken into account the best placement of their athletes in the last race.

The Red Jersey must be worn by the captain identified by the Company, and in case of his absence, the same will be worn by the athlete, starting the race, designated by the same Company.

At the bottom of the Red Jersey has been prepared a space (25x15 cm) for the inclusion of the name of the Athlete's Society (application by the Company itself).

The Red Jersey Club, at the start of a stage, does not deploy an athlete with the jersey ranking will be reduced 100 points. In case the athlete has forgotten his Official Jersey, in order to participate in the race, he must request a new one to the organizer. The value of the Jersey will be retained from the final refunds.

9.4 Jersey Black

It establishes the Black Jersey delivered, at each stage, to the runner who will be ranked in last position in the order of general arrival.

It will be rewarded the commitment to have been able to complete the test. This shirt wants to mean Solidarity, Inclusion and Recognition, because everyone makes the same effort, everyone is committed with great ardor and passion.

As well as tricycles M and W are excluded from this allocation.

The Black Jersey can be worn by the holder to whom it was assigned in the previous stage.

At the bottom of the Black Jersey has been prepared a space (25x15 cm) for the inclusion of the name of the Athlete's Society (application by the Company itself).

9.5 Official Jersey Dressing

The Leaders of the General Ranking, the Young Best Ranking and the Points Society Ranking, must wear the Pink Jersey, the White Jersey and the Red Jersey respectively. This order also establishes a priority between the different Leader meshes; If a runner is a leader of several leaderboards, he will only wear the jersey that has priority in the order above. The other jerseys will be worn, as an honor, by the Runners who follow in the ranking of their respective rankings if they are not holders of another ranking. The Red Jersey follows the indications in the appropriate article. The Black Jersey, not having a ranking, is to be considered last in the above order.

Athletes are obliged to wear official jerseys.

9.6 Award "Overall Winner"

The Award to the Overall Winner of the GHB is established and will be identified among the winners of the general ranking (excluding the Open and T categories). To each athlete (man or woman) who will have reported the absolute best time of race, referred to their position, will be credited, at each test, 5 points more in the general classification (Timing taken at the "Start" and not at the "Flag", that is taken at the passage on the Arrival line).

In the event of a tie between several athletes, the winner of the GHB will be declared the competitor who will have obtained the best placement at the last test; placement given by the best race time.

9.7 Prize "Premio Fair Play - Andrea Conti a.m."

Inspired by the principle of mutual fairness in the conduct of sporting events, the Direction of the Tour, wanted to highlight the behavior of the participants in the race, rewarding the athlete who, with his race conduct and his skills and his means, will prove to have been the most respectful of the regulations.

During the penultimate stage, all athletes will receive an anonymous form to fill out and leave in an urn during the stage awards.

The result of the voting will be evaluated by the Direction of the Tour and during the final awards ceremony of the Last Stage, the Prize will be given to the Athlete better distinguished.

9.8 Award "Best Foreign Athlete"

In order to encourage the participation of foreign athletes, as a result of the points awarded in the General Ranking of the Maglia Rosa, a final prize is established for the first 2 best foreign athletes of the M/W H1 categories, 2,3,4,5 to which a further refund will be paid as shown in the attached table (all.2)

FINAL REPAYMENTS

10.

Expected, for the winners of the General Ranking - Maglia Rosa, an individual refund according to the attached table (all.2)

For post-First placements, an individual refund is provided as per the attached table (all.2).

Participation in the Last Stage is mandatory for the purpose of granting reimbursement and recognition of points that, otherwise, will be reset.

11.

A final refund for the Ranking of Best Young - White Jersey according to the attached table (all.2)

Participation in the Last Stage is mandatory for the purpose of granting reimbursement and recognition of points that, otherwise, will be reset.

12.

Expected a final refund for the Red Jersey - Company Ranking by Points - Fast Team according to the attached table (all.2). The reimbursement to the Company will be paid, in its entirety, only if the half (rounded down) of the athletes, who will have contributed to the amount of points in the ranking, will have participated in at least 6 of the 8 tests planned. If this limit is not reached, the reimbursement in the table will still be paid but reduced by 50%.

13.

A final refund for the "Best Athlete Abroad" according to the attached table (all.2) Participation in the Last Stage is mandatory in order to pay the refund.

14.

The total amount of refunds is € 26,700.00

15.

For administrative needs will NOT be paid individual refunds to athletes. To this end, the prize pool of the Club Points Ranking has been increased. The amounts thus obtained will be liquidated directly to the companies to which they belong. To the Companies that do not respect the ways and timing, communicated with subsequent and special note separately, for the presentation of documentation relating to the reimbursement of participating athletes, will not be recognized any revenge, dispute or complaint.

INFRINGEMENTS, PENALTIES AND COMPLAINTS

16.

Infringements detected during the "GHB" will only be subject to the sanctions provided for in the F.C.I./UCI regulations

17.

Complaints relating to "facts of race" must be submitted in the manner and within the time limits provided by the F.C.I./UCI regulations

18.

The Direction of the Tour, upon the occurrence of situations that damage the image of the Event itself or the Movement in general, may decide to revoke the points and the relative prizes for single stage or, in the most severe cases, exclusion from the final general classification and/or non-participation in one or more stages.

PROTOCOL FOR THE AWARD OF PRIZES

19.

After each stage arrival the winners and the holders of the "Official Jerseys" have the obligation to present themselves with priority to the award ceremony according to ways and times provided by the Organizer. These runners must wear their own uniforms (without wearing or wearing clothing or articles that are not relevant to maintaining decent behaviour) respecting what are the Covid regulations and protocols provided for and regulated by the C.O. and the relative indications provided by the F.C.I./U.C.I. If they were not followed it is the right of the C.O. not to admit to the award ceremony athletes and/ or escorts.

All prize-winning runners who refuse to attend the stage and mesh awards, except in cases of force majeure (medical interventions or health problems), will be confiscated their prizes and stage points. The same runners will be reported to the homologating body for the measures of competence.

Not participating in the final award ceremony, which will take place at the last stage of GHB, will result in the loss of the title and any tabular reimbursement that will be forfeited by the CO without the possibility by any person to provide for the withdrawal in the name and on behalf of the athlete, except in cases of proven necessity or impossibility of the same previously communicated to the C.O. of the GHB. Please note that the obligation to attend the Awards refers to:

- Stage Awards: Official Jerseys holders only
- Final Awards (last stage): The top three classified for the Maglia Rosa e Bianca
- Final Awards (last stage): A representative of Fast Team Red Jersey

GENERAL PROVISIONS

20.

The following shall be bound by this Regulation and, to the extent not covered by it, by the current rules issued by the UCI/FEC:

- The participating athletes;
- Sports Directors, team personnel and/or official escorts;
- All GHB personnel accredited by the Organizers in a recognized and official capacity.

21.

Participation in any of the GHB stage tests implies tacit acceptance of this Regulation.

22.

Departures may be differentiated by Division according to this formula:

- MH3; MH4; MH5; MHO
- MH1; MH2; WH5; WH4; WH3; WH2; WH1; WHO
- Tricycles W - M

The Race Management, in agreement with the Jury, will evaluate the methods of differentiation of the departures according to the number of athletes, the characteristics of the circuit and the time needed for the event.

EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY AND DISPUTES

23.

On the basis of art. 2, by participating in any stage of GHB, each athlete recognizes the exclusion of any and all responsibility of "CO GHB" for personal damage and/ or third parties and/ or material, suffered or caused and without any possibility of retaliation against the CO GHB.

24.

In order to resolve disputes regarding the allocation of mesh scores, premiums and refunds, the GHB Management reserves any specific competence.

REFERENCE TO THE GENERAL RULES

25.

The rules contained in the F.C.I./ U.C.I.

VARIO

26.

Each athlete grants permission to the Organizing Committee to use photographs, tapes, videos, images both on paper and within websites. Personal data will be processed in compliance with Italian law - art. 7 and 13 - D. Lgs 196/03.

27.

The organization, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to amend these regulations and/or the stages included in the calendar and already approved, for reasons which it considers essential for the successful outcome of the event and/or for reasons of force majeure, at the same time communicating them to the Paralympic Sector Commission, or in agreement with the Commission itself.
